Study area: About $5.00 \mathrm{~km}^{2}$

Number of Sketch maps discarded:=4 (The four sketch maps are discarded as they contain very limited information)

Total number of Sketch maps considered: $=20$

## Instructions

The sketch maps are from the small village of an area about $5.00 \mathrm{~km}^{2}$ in the remote Himalayan region of Pakistan. As the study area was big, I divide the sketch area in to two smaller areas. I ask participants to sketch any one of the area. All the sketch maps are generated by different participants and most of them were holding an academic degree at Colleges in Aliabad, Hunza. Most of the participants were residents of the predefined locations, all of them were familiar with the locations by frequent visits by foot or vehicle. During the experiment, participants were asked to produce sketch maps of predefined locations as detailed as possible but only from memory.
